BOARD CHAIR & EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

Montana Nonprofit Association (MNA) came into 2021 anticipating healing and recovery from 2020's COVID-19 pandemic, a worldwide disaster that brought loss of life and livelihood. We were hopeful for a return to normalcy, a period of recovery. Instead, we found ourselves confronting ongoing disruption and unpredictability as new variations of COVID-19 emerged alongside new information about how to respond to an ever-shifting landscape.

In this context MNA continued to offer leadership, support and resources to Montana's nonprofit community. As your advocates to legislators and a new administration, MNA was an effective voice for almost 700 charitable nonprofit members, our strongest membership ever. Despite the ongoing barriers the pandemic presented to participation in the legislature, MNA successfully fought for the rights of nonprofits to petition government, to receive gifts of land, and to be included in Montana's plan for the American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) funds.

In addition to advocacy, MNA offered highly relevant and timely learning programs and resources to a larger nonprofit audience than ever before. Our commitment to equity pushed us to creatively and affordably bring professional development opportunities to any member of a nonprofit organization's staff or board. We used technology, scholarship funds, and "access for all" training registration pricing to minimize financial barriers for organizations interested in growth and development.

As the recipients of tremendous generosity ourselves, MNA's vision has been to meet resource gaps by ensuring Association benefits are accessible to all, regardless of budget size or organizational structure. As a result, not only have we reached more individuals and organizations with more resources than ever before, but we are stronger for it. Our financial condition has never been more solid, and our total membership of almost 800 nonprofits and affiliates is larger than ever.

In 2021, like so many other Montana nonprofits, MNA pressed forward despite uncertainty. And in those moments when we needed to simply persevere, we found our foothold by focusing on service, walking alongside others through the demanding and variable realities of the times, and prioritizing a sustainable pace through it all. Being in community, in association with one another, has never been more important or meaningful. As we greet 2022, we continue to confront ambiguity. Nonetheless, we press forward, moving with strength and gratitude into the future. Our deepest thanks to you for being a part of Montana Nonprofit Association; together, we are a force for good.

GAINING TRACTION

In 2021 Montana Nonprofit Association's goal was to equip nonprofits with the traction needed to rebuild, re-imagine, and redefine their missions, communities, and selves after a challenging 2020. While many government entities, private businesses, and some nonprofit organizations had to shut down during the pandemic, the majority of Montana's 2,200 nonprofit employers remained in service to meet the challenges of the times. Rather than slowing down or shutting down, Montana's nonprofits ramped up their services due to high demand, innovated their operations to navigate the economic downturn, and continued to be resilient in the face of a major workforce shortage and housing crisis. From the thread of tread to the uncomfortable but necessary presence of friction, MNA offered vital capacity-building resources, tools, services, and programs across Montana so that nonprofits gained the traction needed to carry their communities forward.

TRACTION IN ACTION

In 2021, MNA served **5,043** nonprofit professionals through its programming with an average of **39%** of participants hailing from rural communities.

111 Montana nonprofit leaders attended **MNA's Recruit, Retain, Train** series which offered curricula and resources focused on hybrid workforces and best practices in remote working.

20 nonprofit professionals participated in **Catalyst, MNA's Leadership Development Cohort**.

30 nonprofit managers participated in **Accelerator, MNA's Management Cohort**.

569 individuals hailing from rural areas of **Montana** attended at least one **MNA** training.

MNA piloted an **All Access Pass** for **15** organizations. The Pass is now being utilized by hundreds nonprofit professionals and volunteers across Montana.

In collaboration with the **Association of Fundraising Professionals, Montana Chapter**, **MNA** honored philanthropic and nonprofit impact in the state of Montana by awarding **3** individuals and **3** nonprofit organizations with **2021 Montana's Best Awards**.

1,441 nonprofit professionals representing **225** organizations across **Montana** and beyond attended **MNA's 2021 Annual Conference, TRACTION**.

543 nonprofit professionals registered for at least one of **MNA's Affinity Groups** which serve as monthly virtual networking and professional development opportunities.

MNA collaborated with the **University of Montana** to ensure nonprofit leaders have multiple pathways to advance their career interests and abilities via nonprofit administration credentialing and accreditation.

MNA offered **\$6,071** in scholarships to **29** organizations.

MNA published its inaugural **Montana Foundation Directory** establishing an effective tool for both nonprofits and funders in the grantmaking process.

THE 67th MONTANA LEGISLATIVE SESSION

The 2021 Montana Legislative Session was extraordinarily challenging. Although technology was in place for digital participation, advocates quickly came to see that inability to be physically in the rooms and halls of the Capitol impeded both the flow of information and the ability to build relationships and communicate effectively with policymakers.

In 2021 MNA successfully supported two bills which passed and successfully opposed five bills which failed. Most significantly, MNA played a leadership role in a coalition effort that ultimately resulted in a veto of SB278. The legislation would have chilled civic engagement in lobbying and advocacy by triggering a punitive Department of Justice review of all donations of more than \$50 to nonprofits that provided comments supporting or challenging certain governmental actions (e.g., litigation and lobbying). MNA engaged members throughout the session with weekly email updates and/or calls to action which saw in total almost 16,000 opens.



ARPA ADVOCACY

MNA continued to advocate for pandemic-related funding for Montana's nonprofit sector:

- Engaged members in a call to action to Congress to include nonprofit priorities in COVID relief measures.
- Testified on the impact of the pandemic and recommendations relevant to the nonprofit sector to the Joint Select Committee on HB632, the bill which directed the acceptance and use of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in Montana.
- Advocated for nonprofit entities to be eligible for economic transformation funds, one of four ARPA priorities.
- Worked with Montana Association of Counties (MACO) to send a letter to all county commissioners detailing the appropriate role nonprofits could play as partners in local stimulus efforts.

CENSUS 2020 RESULTS

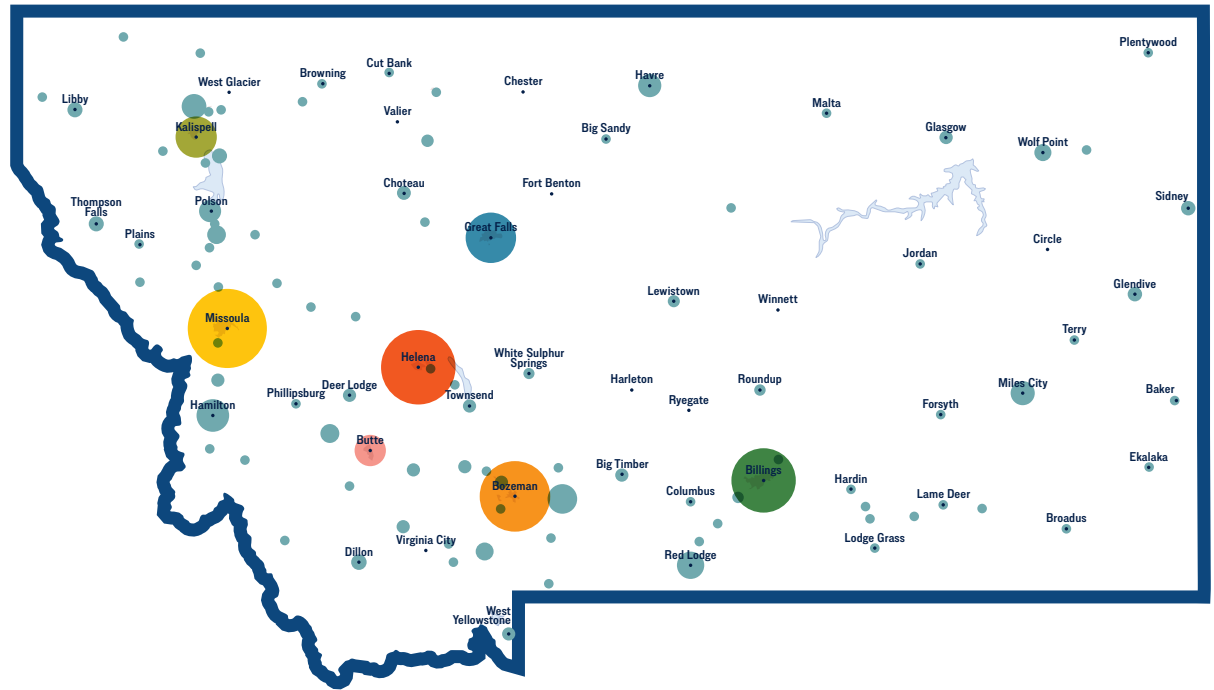

MNA was a leading organization in Montana's Complete Count efforts, working with statewide partners and coalitions to secure a full and complete count despite the significant impacts of COVID on Census efforts in the state.

MEMBERSHIP IN 2021

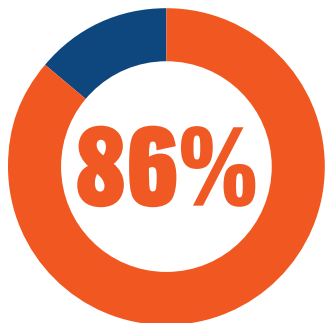

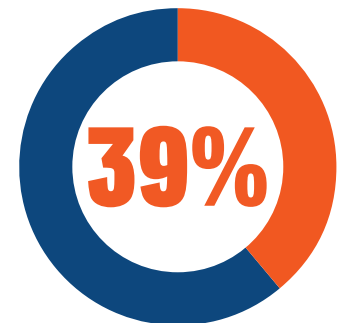

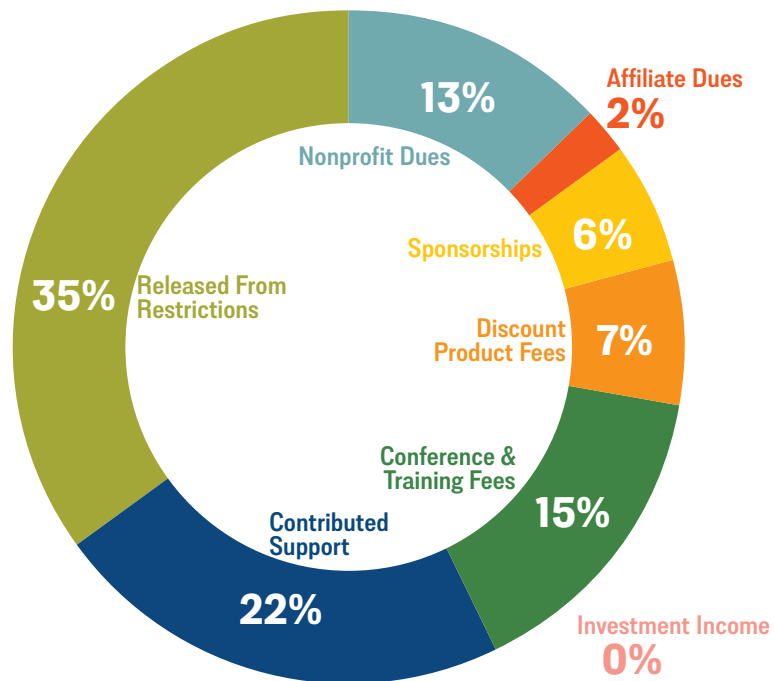

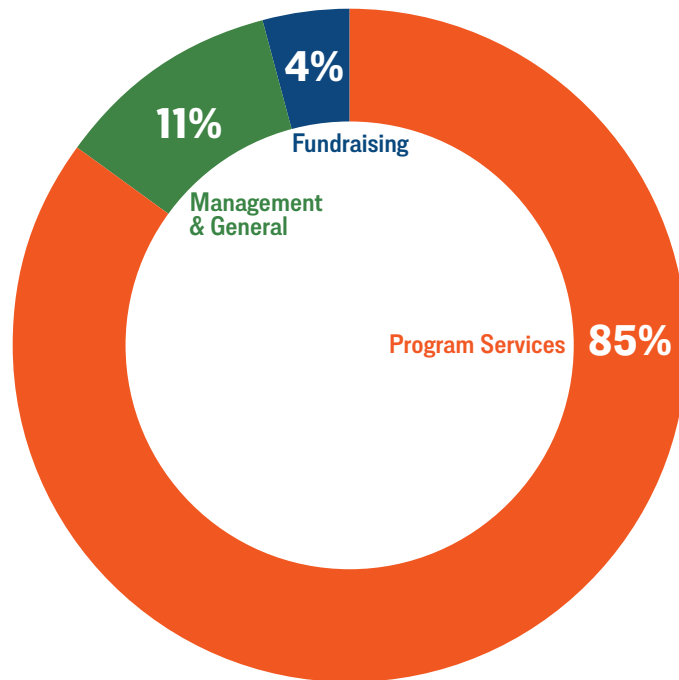
MNA's operational revenue in 2021 equaled \$1,157,649.
